



#### FOR 100 GIRL STUDENTS FROM SOCIAL WELFARE COLLEGES OF TELANGANA STATE

Center for Human Security Studies (CHSS) hosted a research internship programme to bring awareness and knowledge on Internal Security & External affairs of India.100 selected college girls of SC/ST/OBC/General run by Telangana Social Welfare Residential Educational Institutional Society (TSWREIS) benefited out of this rigorous on-campus training programme.





Senior Civi Servants and Academicians have shared their knowledge and experience with the students over several interactive sessions on a daily basis. Special focus was laid on personality development and Life skills. As a result of this programme the girl interns improved their soft skills, time management, English communication skills, along with knowledge of Indian Internal Security challenges, External Affairs of India and International Affairs. The girl interns also had extra-curricular activities which included early morning physical exercises, sports, painting, singing and dance. A select number of girl interns were given the opportunity to visit local media outlets and were interviewed by the local media about their views on current affairs.

Each Intern was also assigned to write a research paper on India's relationship with the country of their choice. The interns completed their assignment by the end of the programme.






The first webinar was held on the 20th of May on the topic "Research paper Orientation and Guidance" by Dr. Francis Raj, Chief Research Advisor, CHSS. The second webinar was held on the 26th of May by Professor J.L.N Rao, Osmania University, on the topic "Human Security in International Relations". The next webinar was held on 29th may on the topic "Visioning and Goal Setting in government - an overview on vision 2029 - Sunrise Andhra Pradesh" by Satyajit Rao Vagvala (Senior General Manager and Vertical head of capacity building and knowledge management at the NISG, (National Institute for Smart Government).
